Step 1: Complete Application for CMCArts Artist-in-Residency Program

CMCArts connects artists with St. Croix and the Caribbean to develop their professional practice while educating and diversifying the arts culture. We provide dedicated time and space in the scenic town of Frederiksted for artists to work, research, and develop while living at the museum in our artist-in-residence apartment.

CMCArts is a non-profit organization, with limited funding sources. We were founded in 1994 as a means of addressing the increase in violence afflicting the youth of St. Croix by providing and teaching alternative forms of positive expression through art. We are a comprehensive working art center for the Virgin Islands and Caribbean Region where people of many cultures and talents can gather to share in creation. CMCArts resident will stay in Historic Frederiksted and will be provided a one bedroom fully furnished apartment with a kitchen and living room/studio space. While here, the artist-in-resident acts as an ambassador to the museum by providing community outreach via workshops, school programs, and artist talks.

To be accepted into CMCArts Artist-in-Residence Program for all artists must complete this application form and email it to CMCArts by October 1. All applications will be reviewed by a committee. Our Education Coordinator will email the artist to set up a time for a phone interview. Based on the application, phone interview, and the space available the artist will find out no later than December 1, if they have been accepted for the program or wait listed. CMCArts prefers teaching residency applications.

Residency Proposals: At CMCArts we offer two types of residencies; a teaching residency and a non-teaching artist residency. Please read both A and B. You may apply for both. Ideally, we are looking for residency programs that will include children or teen workshop series along with an adult workshop.

A. Teaching Residency Proposal: (250 words or less). Outline a potential workshop series for your residency. Please let us know: studio space requirements, special equipment, and any other requirements needed for your planned teaching proposal.

Preferred programs include: little artist (under age 8), youths (age 8-12), and or teens (age 13-18). Adult programs will also be considered.

*Grant Stipend often need to include workshops for participants under 18.

B. Non-Teaching Residency Proposal: (250 words or less). Outline a potential plan for your residency. What do you plan to accomplish while staying as an artist-in-residence. Teaching is not required, instead you are focusing on your discipline.

Please note you will be required to pay \$150 per night for a minimum 7-night stay in the artist-in-resident apartment. Once accepted into the program you will pay 50% deposit for your stay and the deposit is non-refundable.



Teaching Residency Stipend: We are a small art museum and art center. CMCArts actively applies for grants, and we have awarded artist-in-residence \$1,000 stipend when possible. Artist are responsible for travel expenses, food, car rental, and personal art supplies. Please be advised that everything is more expensive on island than in the states.
