All works need to be able to be shipped to CMCARTS, St. Croix, US Virgin Islands so maximum size of canvas or paper should be no more than 2 feet (24”) x 2 feet (24”) or smaller. Work must have been made within the last 3 years.

Please send good quality photographs with the description and other details as requested, refer below. If selected, the artist must promptly ship the piece for framing on or before April 8^h. All selections will be notified by March 21st. Artists can submit up to 2 pieces of art (for the exhibition) and must be members of the LGBT+ community. We recommend sending between 2 and 4 images of your work so the curator may gain insight into your artistic experience.

There is no need to submit a resume, C.V., or bio at this stage of the call. If you are selected to exhibit during the Pride exhibition (June 2023), we will ask you then to provide us with these documents.
